HEADQUARTERS:

The TGOA/MGCA office is located about one-half mile north of Interstate 35-80 in Johnston, IA. STAFF:

TGOA/MGCA Office Manager: Communications with public and members, TGOA/MGCA documents, TGOA/MGCA directories, conventions and board of director meetings, duplicating, purchasing, shipping, newsletter editor, and assistant membership manager and bookkeeper.

Membership Manager/Bookkeeper: Financial records, duplicating, shipping and backup to office manager.

Groundskeeper: Part time maintenance man and volunteers

BANKING/FINANCES:

MEMBERSHIP:

All membership records are kept by member number/name and by club/region number on computers, and in a club roster file.

Membership fee is \$15.00 annually (due January 1.)

Family membership fee is \$23.00 annually for the first two members plus \$5.00 for each additional member at the same address.

Clubs are provided with a membership listing of the previous year, which is to be forwarded to TGOA/MGCA office with dues payment. Clubs should submit current copy of membership roster to their region with Region dues payment, if any.

CLARIFICATION OF SERVICES:

Any officer, director, or committee chairman can expect to receive organizational information requests. If unable to provide information, contact TGOA/MGCA headquarters.

CONVENTION BUSINESS:

Notification of "call for business" is provided to each member of the board of directors, prior to the convention. Business may be presented to the president, prior to call to order of the board meeting, only in written form with name of responsible individual(s) given.

The Gardeners of America Inc./Men's Garden Clubs of America, Inc. is an affiliation of clubs and members-at-large.

The board of directors is the governing body.

COMMITTEES:

Committee selection sheets are available to all members at each convention, and mailed to each club for input. Appointment to a committee is determined by the president-elect each year and approved at the annual meeting of the board of directors.

Committee expenses are budgeted each year. Approval for committee expenditures (reimbursement forms) must be directed to the vice-president in charge of the committee for signature approval before payment is made.

LIBRARY

A "lending" library is maintained at headquarters for members to utilize and/or request books to be sent to them for their reading and/or book review for the cost of postage. Book reviews will be published in the semi-monthly newsletters.

TGOA/MGCA CALENDARS:

Each year TGOA/MGCA develops and publishes its' own calendar. These are available at a reduced price to the clubs, for sale as a fundraising project, for both TGOA/MGCA and the affiliated clubs. Orders are directed to headquarters and shipment is usually made within 24 hours. Payment in full is to be made upon receipt of shipment.

CLUB CORRESPONDENCE:

All materials and items relating to TGOA/MGCA and affiliated clubs is directed to the <u>DIRECTOR/LIASON OR CLUB PRESIDENT</u>. Director/liaison person is responsible to provide information to club members on national programs.
